We've had a full summer with Concerts on the Creek – and have been blessed with record crowds this year. On three different nights, we asked fans to raise their hand if they were a guest, defining 'guest' as someone who traveled more than 30 miles to attend. Each time, more than 2/3 of our audience indicated they were guests. Our newly installed acrylic units on the exterior walls of the Dillsboro public restroom are working GREAT and we have been restocking every other day. We've updated our merchandise for the fall season and our new Christmas ornaments are on the way. We've spent time connecting with businesses on Hwy. 107 that have relocated or in the process of relocating and worked with DOT and the county on providing available rental options, as well as grant funding. Our team coordinated a Dillsboro clean up day with the SMHS Varsity Football team, which was very successful. We helped with the downtown Sylva clean up day by weeding beds, spreading mulch and picking up trash. We know first impressions of our county make a BIG difference to guests - we hear daily! Our first Summer Mixer specifically for Realtors is coming up August 18th and we are excited to connect with our local realtors and do a better job connecting potential relocators with the appropriate Realtor who can assist them. Dining Guide inventory is running low, so we are now being more selective about providing large quantities to hotels and lodging facilities. This is the first year in 9 years that we have had to limit the Our Town disbursals. We have disbursed more on site to potential relocators than we have in almost a decade. We've expanded our Relocation offerings in our Center and are working daily to provide everything from recycling locations to demographics to Realtor and rental info. We definitely can tell guests are appreciative of this service and the resources.
