We have been enjoying record setting crowds at Concerts on the Creek, which started May 24th and will conclude on August 30th. **Special thanks to Nick** for helping us secure the digital use of the USA Today #6 ranking brand for Outdoor Concerts series venues. On average, the fire department team on duty have counted between 900-1200 people in attendance. Our restaurants are very busy on Friday nights, and two of our retail members in downtown reported that they are making more sales between 5-7 pm than all day. We love hearing this – because it helps confirm that Concerts on the Creek does create an economic impact on the area. We held four ribbon cuttings in May and two in June. We have restocked all TDA kiosk boxes with the freshly updated and printed maps supplied by the TDA, as well as larger area lodging facilities. We are happy to report that we received a grant from the MSSA and are in the process of updating our new paver patio with lighting, plants, furniture, bird feeders and more to make it an attractive place for our guests and locals. The newly refreshed WCU room has been a big hit and Paws is super popular with new parents and students that are learning more about the area.
